

RGU team inspects Doimukh College

DOIMUKH, Jun 10: The 'RGU Inspection Team', a committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi University on Monday visited Government College Doimukh for physical verification in connection with granting of permanent affiliation and introduction of new course i.e. BA Geography as per UGC norms. Committee convener Prof Nabam Nakha Hina, Director of College Development Council and Chairman Prof Nishamani Kar, Department of Geography inspected the college to have a look on its documents, physical infrastructure. The members interacted with the faculty, staff and students of the college. Prof Hina emphasized on need of punctuality, honesty and transparency of faculties and staff while discharging their duties and responsibilities. Calling them nation builders, the professor asserted that teachers are the backbone of the society. With regards to development of educational institutions, Prof Kar suggested that the authorities and policy makers must take institutions into confidence before framing policies. Feedback is must for upliftment of education system. She also suggested for preserving pluralism within the institution and inter-institution resource sharing for the all round development of the system.
