

RGU lift 3rd Teachers' Trophy

ITANAGAR, Sep 15: Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) lifted the 3rd Teachers' Trophy, beating Himalayan University 4-1 in the final match played at the DNGC playground here on Sunday.
