Khandu advises students to embrace discipline

ITANAGAR, Sep 26: Chief Minister Pema Khandu today advised the students of Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) to embrace discipline saying such behavior helps in focusing on studies and overcoming any challenges of life. Speaking during the 'orientation of fresher's-cum- induction ceremony' organized by the Rajiv Gandhi University Students Union (RGUSU) here, the chief minister said the foremost duty of a student on the campus is towards their studies. He said in this young age, there is a risk of students going down the wrong path, as it may seem attractive to them. "But such urges must be contained with self-discipline and training your mind to overcome any such challenges," he said. Stating that competition for leading a better life is stiffening every moment, he advised the students to prepare themselves taking advantage of the good learning atmosphere provided in the University campus. He also said whatever career or path one chooses in life, he advised them to be sincere and honest, as it will always save them from unnecessary trouble. The chief minister assured the students that meritocracy will always prevail in the state. He said a politician's duty is to create jobs and opportunities for its people. However, they don't have the right to appoint people to these jobs as inducements or for bribes. The Staff Selection Board (SSB) created recently is to ensure fairness in such job recruitment and informed that the board is presently working in full swing in recruiting policemen for the state police. The chief minister further invited the RGU students to apply for Chief Minister Fellowship programme, and to contribute themselves for betterment of the state. On a memorandum submitted by RGUSU, the chief minister assured that electricity issues and demand for a new fleet of buses for University will be fulfilled. On encroachment issue, Khandu directed the Papum Pare district administration to solve the matter at the earliest and forever.
