

Wrong urges must be contained with self-discipline, says CM

ITANAGAR, Sep 26: Chief Minister Pema Khandu while stating that restrained action helps in focusing on studies and overcoming any challenges of life has called upon the students of Rajiv Gandhi University to embrace discipline. Speaking at the 'orientation of freshers cum induction ceremony' organized by the Rajiv Gandhi University Students' Union (RGUSU) today, Khandu said the foremost duty of a student in the campus is towards their studies. He said at this young age there is risk of students going down the wrong path, as it may seem attractive to them. "But such urges must be contained with self-discipline and training your mind to overcome any such challenges," he felt. Stating that competition for leading a better life is stiffening every moment, he advised the students to prepare themselves taking advantage of the good learning atmosphere provided in the University campus. He also said whatever career or path one chooses in life, he advised them to be sincere and honest, as it will always save them from unnecessary trouble. While assuring the students that meritocracy will always prevail in the state, Khandu said a politician's duty is to create jobs and opportunities for its people. However, they don't have the right to appoint people to these jobs as inducements or for bribes. The Staff Selection Board (SSB) created recently is to ensure fairness in such recruitment and informed that the board is presently working full swing in making recruitments for the state police. Chief Minister further invited the RGU students to apply for Chief Minister Fellowship programme, and to contribute themselves for betterment of the state. To a memorandum submitted by RGUSU, Chief Minister assured that electricity issues and demand for new fleet of buses for University will be fulfilled. On encroachment issue, he directed the Papum Pare district administration to solve the matter at the earliest. MLA Doimukh Tana Hali Tara and RGU VC Prof Saket Kushwaha also spoke
