RGU gets a new auditorium



RONO HILLS, Sep 30: Governor BD Mishra today inaugurated a new auditorium building of the Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) at the University campus here. The auditorium has been constructed at an estimated cost of Rs 10.21 crore, funded by DoNER. At present, the facility houses the Fine Arts department. Interacting with the faculty and the students, the governor advised the university authority and students for maximum utilization of the facility. “You are fortunate for such a beautiful facility,” the governor said while recalling the challenges of his student period. The governor, who is chief rector of the RGU and brand ambassador of Swachh Bharat Mission, emphasized that the new auditorium must be given good upkeep. Earlier, on his arrival at the RGU University Campus, the governor paid tributes at the ‘Wall of Heroes’. The Wall of Heroes, an initiative of the Vidya Veerta Abhiyan under the aegis of the Union ministry of Human Resource Development, pays homage to war heroes decorated with ‘Param Vir Chakra’ gallantry award. The portraits of 21 war heroes were handed over to the RGU in a distribution ceremony at National Media Centre, New Delhi by the MoHRD. RGU is one of the first central universities in the Northeast to make and dedicate such display in the best spirit of nationalism. Home minister Bamang Felix, State Election Commissioner Hage Kojeen, RGU vice-chancellor Prof Saket Kushwaha, and RGU registrar Prof Tomo Riba were present on the occasion.
