## ANYA memorandum to Governor on RGU land issue

ITANAGAR, Oct 23: The All Nyishi Youth Association (ANYA) has submitted a representation to the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh-cum-Chief Rector, Rajiv Gandhi University today and urged to reclaim missing of 64 acres of land allotted to Rajiv Gandhi University, and conduct judicial enquiry on missing of original sketch map of university.

The Rajiv Gandhi University is the only central university of Arunachal Pradesh. The local people of Doimukh, Emchi, Rono and Leka had generously sacrificed to donate their land for the establishment

of university in 1985 to produce human resources in the state.

As per Vice Chancellor's press statement on dated 29, October 2018, it was came to know that 64 Acres of university land is missing which is not suitable for further expansion of university infrastructure development and it is also created a bad image to entire state.

It has also come to learn that some individual have encroached the university's land and erected a permanent structures. It needed stringent action as per appropriate prevailing law of land to reclaim encroached land.

The university authority should identify the encroachers and submit details to the competent authority for early eviction. It is questionable that university authority has unable to find out the encroachers till date and issued NOC to LPC applicants by the University authority without proper verification may be the reason of missing of land.

The Deputy Commissioner, Yupia, Papum Pare district had submitted a report no. DC/LM/PP/GOVT/019/09/006/18 dated Yupia the 5th November 2018 is yet to be implemented by Rajiv Gandhi University authority.

The distortion of original map was the main cause of encroachment of university land which needs proper investigation on missing of original map from the custodian of university authority. Without involvement of university authority, the missing of original map had not been possible and we request him to constitute a judicial enquiry against the university authority.

The All Nyishi Youth Association (ANYA) urged him to conduct a proper investigation on missing of original map of Rajiv Gandhi University's original map containing of 302 acres of land.
