RGU signs MoU with Brno University of Technology



RONO HILLS, Oct 22: Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) here today signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Brno University of Technology, Brno, Czech Republic for collaborative researches in scientific issues of natural, engineering, and technical sciences as well as for research and exchange programmes of faculty and students of both the universities. The MoU was signed by Prof Tomo Riba, Registrar in-charge of RGU and Prof Petr Stepanek, the Rector of Brno University of Technology, in presence of RGU Vice Chancellor Prof Saket Kushwaha. The MoU aims at providing new avenues for access, sharing and developing technical know-how between the two varsities, initially for next five years.
