

RGU organises workshop on career planning

RONO HILL, Nov 19: More than 150 students participated in a two-day workshop on 'Career planning and opportunities in the organised sector', organised by Rajiv Gandhi University's (RGU) management department, in association with the university's career counselling cell, on 18 and 19 November.
