Peaceful sit-in protest staged at RGU

RONO HILLS, Dec 17: A peaceful sit-in protest against the Citizenship (Amendment) Act (CAA), 2019 launched at the Rajiv Gandhi University campus by one Misso Nobin has entered the third day today. Nobin stated, "If there is no positive sign for the people of Assam and Tripura and the North East as a whole after the first day of hearing from the Supreme Court tomorrow, then the protest will escalate on a larger scale". Despite the ongoing university semester exams, the RGU students are persistent in continuing the sit-in protest against the CAA. The agitators were later joined by the RGU faculties. They also urged the youth to realize the harm the Act could bring to the indigenous people of the state. The protestors also condemned the act of violence in the aftermath of the CAA. Sunku, a mass communication student stated, "The incident in Jamia Milia Islamia where the students were baton-charged by the police is a clear violation of democratic values. This is condemnable and completely unjustifiable. We will continue supporting the dharnas till the Act is withdrawn from the entire NE region".
