## Modi says exams not everything



RONO HILLS, Jan 20: Prime Minister Narendra Modi today spoke to students from across the country, including those in Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU), that examinations are not everything. He was speaking during his 'Pariksha pe Charcha' program. Telecasted from Talkatora Stadium, New Delhi, broadcast was organized by the RGU at the Smart Theatre in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering. Interacting with students ahead of the board examinations, he said that good marks in examinations are not everything and "we have to come out of the thinking that exams are everything". In fact, a setback may mean the best is yet to come." At the live event 2,000 students, teachers and parents with over 1,000 students who have been selected through an essay competition took part.
