Anti-plagiarism training held

RONO HILLS, Jan 23: A one-day Web Based Training Programme on URKUND-Plagiarism Detecting Software was held today at the Smart Conference Hall of the Rajiv Gandhi University's (RGU) department of Computer Science and Engineering here. The programme was organized by the Central Library, RGU in collaboration with the eGalactic URKUND training and support team. The web training was offered by the executives of the eGalactic, Pune, India, a service provider company of URKUND. URKUND offers a fully automated system for handling plagiarism. Under the aegis of Union ministry of HRD, URKUND Plagiarism Detection Software has been selected by the INFLIBNET Centre (Inter University Centre of UGC). It is being rolled out to all the universities and institutions (CFTIs and other institute of national importance) through centrally funded scheme to enhance the quality and the originality in academic and research works. The participating faculty members and research scholars discussed and raised questions on various issues during the session.
