

## Health centre upgraded with new equipment

**RONO HILLS, Feb 28:** The Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) today upgraded its University Health Centre with the addition of new equipment. RGU Vice-Chancellor, Prof Saket Kushwaha, dedicated three brand new auto analyzers including a fully automated Hematology analyzer (five-part), biochemistry autoanalyzer, and hormonal assay auto analyzer. An automated analyzer is a medical laboratory instrument designed to measure different chemicals and other characteristics in a number of biological samples quickly used to measure properties of blood and other fluids for the diagnosis of diseases. Kushwaha informed that that several medical schemes for campus resident will be launched with a target to provide basic minimum medical facilities. RGU senior medical officer, Dr Akin Tana Tara, informed that the equipment will benefit the campus residents and those living in its periphery.
