## **RGU holds workshop on ‘Campus placement & career counseling for civil services’**

**RONO HILLS, Mar 2:** A one day workshop on ‘Campus Placement and Career Counseling for civil services’ was organized today at the Rajiv Gandhi University campus jointly by the Placement Cell and Career Counseling Cell of RGU for creating awareness about campus placement and to give career counseling for civil service aspirants among the varsity students. Around 570 students from NERIST, NIT Yupia and Govt College Doimukh participated in the programme, which was inaugurated by Prof Saket Kushwaha, RGU vice chancellor. In his address, Prof Kushwaha while emphasizing on the importance of placement activities and career counseling centers in the university urged upon the university community to make the RGU number one in producing quality students to enable them to get good placement. On the occasion, the chief guest also released the Placement Bulletin for the year 2019-20. He also stressed on organizing such workshop in every quarter of the year henceforth. Further, he suggested the students to do SWOT (Strength, weakness, opportunity, and Threat) analysis, so that they can know their weaknesses and can work on it. Finally, he assured to make the university’s civil service and NET coaching programmes more visible in coming days. Prof Amitava Mitra, Pro VC of RGU, in his speech, highlighted the background of the establishment of placement cell in RGU and informed about the role played by each and every department of the university. Earlier, Prof Tasi Kaye, Programme Director and Professor in-charge, Placement Cell, also spoke. Asit Das, General Manager (HR), Brahmaputra Cracker and Polymer Limited (BCPL), Dibrugarh and Dr Raza Hamid, senior consultant of Khan Study Group (KSG) institute for IAS coaching, New Delhi, attended as resource persons. Asit Das delivered a lecture on importance of campus placement and how to build up better personality. He discussed about how companies are turning towards higher education institution to tap best human resources. Dr Hamid while motivating the students to focus more on civil service preparation during the 2nd technical session of the workshop also dwelt at length about the role of coaching institutes towards moulding the aspirants’ mindset to go for civil services.

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
